

SIG Riser 2M Fun Fly & Thermal Duration Event

Location: *Hunting Creek RC Club Field
N. Wilkesboro, NC*

Date: *April 28, 2012*

Time: *9:00AM - 3:00PM*

Landing Fee: *Free*

Info: The Caldwell AeroModelers (CAM) and the Hunting Creek RC Club (HCRCC) will host a Sig Riser 2M Fun Fly and thermal duration (TD) at the Hunting Creek club field in North Wilkesboro, NC. Directions are available on the CAM web site at: www.caldwellaeromodelers.com

CAM and HCRCC invites all 2m Riser flyers to participate in this event. The TD event is meant to be a "low key" intro to sailplane competition. Participation in the TD competition can be on an individual, team or club basis as you choose. Launch methods will be high start and/or winch.

CAM and HCRCC club members are building several Risers for this event and will follow the following rules for their builds:

- OK for plans, kit or ARF build
- OK for carbon on the wood spar
- OK for larger wing rod
- OK to add spoilers (must be disabled for TD flights)
- OK to reshape and fiberglass the kit fuselage and finish it as you please
- OK for one or two piece wing

- OK to use either screws or rubber bands to hold down the wings
- OK to choose your own electronics and layout
- Decorate as you like
- No skegs will be allowed in the contest (you won't need one)
- Other considerations:

The basic guideline is to make internal improvements (lighter, stronger, easier to transport) and not external enhancements to the wing or tail group (bigger wing, different shape wing, different airfoil).

The event directors will have the last word on whether a model modification may be entered in the TD event. If your modification(s) falls outside of these rules it would be a good idea to ask first.

If you already have a Riser, dust it off and get it ready to fly. If your Riser has an electric motor in the nose, we'll "rubber band" the prop and you'll be good to go.

Rules for 2m Riser Thermal Duration Event will be:

- * Fly during a three hour launch window to accomplish five logged flights
- *Launch as many times a you like but logged flights must be recorded immediately upon landing.
- *Bonus points for landing accuracy
- *Longest total time takes home the coveted "Golden Glider Trophy"
