Minutes of Monthly Meeting –February

- The meeting was opened by President Seth Nagy who began by welcoming all members and guests who were present.
- Brett Springall delivered the treasurers report which was accepted by all members after a motion made by Jack Adams which was seconded by Bliss Teague.
- A motion to accept the minutes as published in the February newsletter was made by Ron Miller, was seconded by Bliss Teague, and was accepted by all members present.
- There were 16 members and 3 guests attending
- Kevin Staniszewski introduced himself and his son Jason. Kevin is new to the area and has been aero modeling for several years. All members present accepted Kevin's application for membership.
- Seth Nagy introduced Terry Gilliland for membership. Terry is learning to fly, and all members accepted Terry's application for membership.
- Richard Haas delivered the safety report and reminded us that we continue to be accident free.
- Jack Adams delivered a field report, and updated the club on the progress made at the March 23rd work day.
