# June meeting minutes

- \* Seth Nagy opened the meeting and welcomed all members and guests. He then passed out and received approval of the proposed meeting agenda.

- \* Don Bourdon delivered an abbreviated financial report for Brett Springall. As of June 1st the club had a balance of \$1190.50 in our account.
- \* Seth Nagy reported that Tony Tripplet had paid his club dues and that Jason Starnes had been reinstated into club membership. The club also unanimously approved the reacceptance of former club member Jody Greer.
- \* Richard Haas gave the Safety Report noting there were no accidents at the field since the last meeting.
- \* Jack Adams presented the Field Report and began by thanking Gary and Justin Pearson for weeding and spraying the runway. Jason Starnes will mow the field area and Jack will weed kill around the pilot stations before the June 28 speed rally/fun-fly. The porta-jon is also scheduled for servicing before the speed rally.
